



Kintsugi is a Japanese art which consists of restoring pottery with a particular type of tree sap dusted with gold powder to highlight the restorations. Vancouver-based artist Naoko Fukumaru will talk about embracing weakness and fragility, creating new works from broken pottery, and understanding the life and evolution of ceramics. The talk will also address the differences between Western and Japanese kintsugi practices, as well as the origins, influences, materials, and processes associated with kintsugi.
