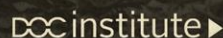

Join us for the film screening event to commemorate the 80th anniversary of the end of the Second World War. "Landscapes of Home" explores the lives of two doctors, Henry Ryusuke Shibata and Stuart Cooper Robinson, whose worlds are disrupted by WWII. Shibata endures internment in Canada, while Robinson is uprooted from Japan. The documentary highlights their resilience and reflects on the Japanese-Canadian experience, redefining the meaning of home amid war, displacement, and loss. (2024, 55 minutes)

The screening will be followed by talk with Alice Il Shin, director, Eiko Kawabe Brown, producer and Dr. Shibata.



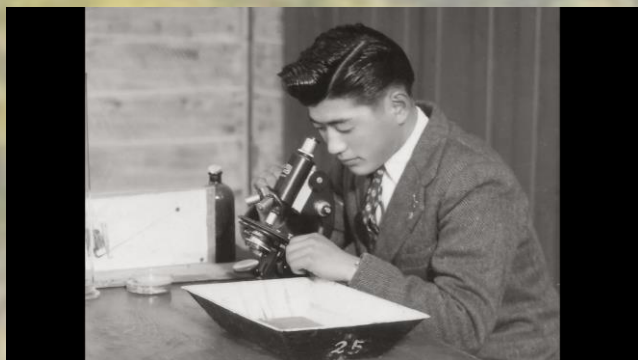
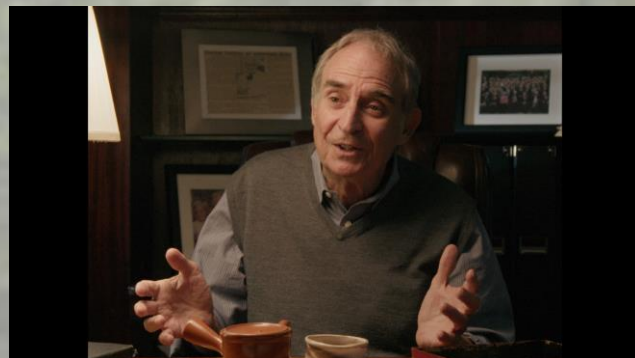
