

THE JAPANESE ARTS OF CALLIGRAPHY (SHODO) AND PAINTING (SUMI-E)

A JOURNEY IN ART FROM EAST TO WEST

Ms. Heather MacDonald, an Ottawa artist who has been teaching Shodo and Sumi-e for over 15 years at the Ottawa School of Art and who completed her artist residency in Japan in spring 2025, will present a brief overview of how Sumi-e and other Japanese art forms influenced Western arts. The presentation will focus on the growth and development of Shodo and Sumi-e in the West as well as Ms. MacDonald's journey of discovery and teaching of those artforms while highlighting the importance of preserving traditional techniques and exploring modern painting ideas.
